WE HAVE ALWAYS HAD A HEART FOR ADOPTION, BEING THAT ALYSSA, HERSELF, IS ADOPTED.

Before we even knew we would have infertility troubles, we had always talked about adopting and had planned to adopt at some point. We tried to conceive naturally for nearly ten years, and when we realized that it just wasn't going to happen, we both knew adoption was the way we would grow our family. Adoption has already played such a large role in our family both with Alyssa and other family members, that we feel we offer a unique opportunity in truly understanding what our future child and their birth family will go through, and how we can show love and support to both.

### Alyssa's adoption story

I was adopted in 1990 when I was just 30 days old. My parents were fantastic with making sure that I always knew I was adopted, in fact I can't remember a time that I didn't know I was adopted! At the time that I was adopted open adoptions were not the norm, so I grew up having a closed adoption and always wanting to know my story. I love my family, my parents are amazing, but I still felt like a part of me was missing.

My parents supported my decision and promised they would help me find my birth family however they could. In January of 2019, my adoption case file was opened. I was searching the internet hoping to find my birth mother and was able to find her through my sister-in-law on Facebook. I found that my birth parents got married two years after I was born and have been together ever since. My birth parents, brothers, and their significant others all live in southern Indiana. Meeting my birth family, my first family, I started to heal inside and feel for the first time like I am whole. My birth family is so incredibly excited for us to be growing our family, one of my brother's has two children with a third on the way so they will have even more cousins to play with!

Growing up not knowing my story has been a huge push for Sean and I to have an open adoption in which our future child will have access to his or her entire story. We hope to have a true relationship with our future child's birth family so that our child can see that they were loved from the start by both families. We want our future child to have what I didn't have growing up and never have to live with the frustration of not knowing and fantasizing over the unknown.


