



I am so thankful that I received a life-saving transplant from a family friend, but it meant my body was not capable of getting pregnant. My transplanted kidney is doing very well and is expected to last me a long time. I have always known that I could raise and love a child unconditionally. I am grateful to also have several close friends and family members in my life who are adoptees; and for the advice and support they have given Bryan and I in our decision to adopt. They have taught me that every adoptee and their story is unique and the importance of belonging. Your child would grow with many people who understand adoption.






#### WE LIVE IN A SAFE, FAMILY-FRIENDLY NEIGHBORHOOD.
