what led up to adoption?

Early in our relationship, we began discussing adoption, largely due to Kiersten's family history—her dad, aunt, and many cousins were adopted. This oriented Kiersten's heart towards adoption, and Daniel was fully onboard. Our discussions became more serious after Kiersten was diagnosed with Stage II endometriosis at the age of 19.

Early in our marriage, we tried fertility treatments as recommended by our doctor, but the emotional and physical toll was too overwhelming, so we shifted our focus to Kiersten's health and processing the grief of infertility. A year later, we started the adoption process and welcomed our son, Luca, into our home in late 2019.

We chose an open adoption, inspired by Kiersten's dad reconnecting with his birth family and the relationships we've built with them. It's important for us that Luca, and any future children, have the opportunity to build relationships with their birth families. Additionally, having a community of adoptees within our family and community has greatly supported Luca in processing his adoption; so, we wanted you to know your child would have access to both adult and child adoptees to process their story with.

Our hearts are open, ready, and excited to expand our family again through adoption.
